A BALB/c mouse was immunized with human rTNF-alpha. Fusion partner: NS-1.

Specifications

EBS-0-175 reacts with human TNF-alpha and not with mouse TNF-alpha. This antibody neutralises Hu-rTNFa-mediated cytotoxicity of L929 cells and inhibits tumor growth in mice. It protects mice against toxicity of Hu-rTNFa.

Species reactivity

Positive: human. Negative: mouse.




Figure 1: Human histiocytoma stained for TNF alpha (frozen)

Format

Produced in tissue culture, contains no host Ig. Antibodies are affinity purified and presented in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide.

Stored at 4°C-8°C, shelf life is at least 24 months after purchase.

Dilution advice

- \triangleright ELISA (solid phase: 0,1-100 µg/ml; tracer: 0,001-100 µg/ml for 30 min at RT).
- Flow cytometry $(0,5-1,0 \mu g/million cells in 0,1ml)$.
- \triangleright Immunoblotting (1-2 µg/ml).
- Immunofluorescence (1-2 μg/ml).
- Inhibits tumor growth (order Ab without BSA/azide).
- \triangleright Immunohistology (1-2 μg/ml for 30-60 minutes at RT; for staining of formalin-fixed tissues no suitable antigen retrieval method is known to date).
- > Neutralizes rTNF-alpha mediated cytotoxicity (order Ab without azide).
- Protects mice against toxicity of rhTNF-alpha (order Ab without azide).

Positive control

HeLa, HL-60, or A431 cells. Macrophages in lymph node or tonsil.

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
